Apply for Financial Aid

Schedule Pre-admission Exams

(Required of all applicants) WorkKeys must be completed prior to interview.

Interview with Commander

Once all ◆ items have been completed, you may call 419-238-5411, ext. 2116 to schedule your interview with the Commander. A \$100 deposit is required for students accepting a seat in the program.

A Physical Examination Form

Must be completed by a physician (Chiropractors are not acceptable)

Background Check

We recommend you go to the Van Wert County Sheriff's Office to have the FBI and Ohio Bureau of Investigation (BCI) check completed. There is no charge for this if completed at the Van Wert County Sheriff's Office. If you choose to go else where, you are responsible for any costs incurred.

Driving Record

Will need to secure your driving record through your local Bureau of Motor Vehicle's Office and submit a copy.

Physical Condition

Assessments will be conducted prior to admission. All Basic Peace Office Training participants are required to complete an assessment and perform to the 15<sup>th</sup> percentile of fitness based on your gender and age as defined by the New Cooper Age and Gender Base Standards for Law Enforcement.
