Apply for Financial Aid

Complete your 2022-2023 FAFSA online at www.fafsa.gov. Our federal school code is 030956. Discuss results with the financial aid office to determine your aid eligibility. For questions or help filing the FAFSA call 419-238-5411, ext. 2110.

Meet with Enrollment Coordinator

Required of all applicants. Program requirements will be discussed along with costs, pre-requisites and completion of required forms.

Submit Program Application

\$30 non-refundable fee required to submit an application.

Schedule Pre-Admission Exams

(Required of all applicants) WorkKeys must be completed prior to taking the HESI exam. Applicants will be notified by the Assessment Coordinator of their test scores and eligibility to take the HESI exam. Applicants are responsible for the cost for both exams.

Program Acceptance

Once all admission criteria have been completed and submitted, the faculty committee will review the application for acceptance. You will be notified by mail of their decision. A \$200 deposit applied towards your tuition is required for students accepting a place in the program.

Drug Screening

Students are responsible for their drug screening fee. Must be completed before acceptance.

BCI/FBI Check

Students are responsible for the cost of their first BCI/FBI background check. Must be completed before acceptance. OBN requires an additional BCI/FBI check prior to taking the licensure exam. This fee is included in the NCLEX licensure expenses.

<u>Health Requirements</u>

Physical Health Form indicating capability of participation. Must be completed before acceptance.

Immunizations (must be completed before acceptance) exact costs will vary depending on the student's insurance and previous immunization history. Often, health care employers will provide Mantoux, Influenza and Hepatitis B vaccinations free of charge for their employees. Students who can provide documentation of having been previously vaccinated or an acceptable titer level demonstrating immunity do not need to repeat the vaccine. Official documentation from the county health department, employer, or the physician's office, etc. must accompany the physical health form. Copies of lab titers must also be submitted.

**Students are responsible for the cost of these health requirements: Physical Examination - \$67 (estimates without insurance)
Prices reflect current costs through the VW County Health
Department: 2-step Mantoux (TB skin Test) - \$40 for each test. Any student with a positive Mantoux in the past will QuantifFeron Gold or Tspot to confirm they are free of communicable TB. T-dap - \$66, Varicella vaccines - \$240 each (series of 2), MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) vaccines - \$162 each (series of 2), Hepatitis B vaccines - \$180 each (series of 3), Influenza vaccine - \$32
