☐ **Submit Program Application** \$30

A \$30 non-refundable application fee is required.

☐ **Schedule Pre-entrance Exam** \$75

Pass required pre-entrance exam **Workkeys**.

☐ **Background Check (BCI/FBI)** \$70

To be completed at Vantage Career Center. The office is open Monday through Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

☐ **Drug Screening** \$41

☐ **Mantoux Tests (TB Test)**

Must be completed prior to the first day of clinical.
2-step test Mantoux tests take two weeks and must be completed before the start of clinical

- ☐ Students who can provide documentation of being previously vaccinated, demonstrating immunization or an acceptable titer level do not need to repeat the vaccine. This is a requirement that must be completed before the start of clinical.

☐ **Financial Assistance**

This program does not qualify for federal financial aid since it is less than 600 clock hours in length. Tuition assistance may be available through your employer, Ohio Means Jobs from the county where you live, or VA Educational Benefits—Veterans can apply for their benefits through the financial aid office.

Health Requirements

Exact costs will vary depending on the student's insurance and previous immunization history. Often, health care employers will provide Mantoux, influenza and hepatitis B vaccinations free of charge for their employees.
