# □ <u>Submit Program Application</u> \$30

A \$30 non-refundable application fee is required.

# □ <u>Schedule Pre-entrance Exam</u> \$75

Pass the required pre-entrance exam, Workkeys.

### <u>Physical Examination Form SF114</u> \$71

Option 1 – Contact Ohio Health to schedule a Physical Exam. The cost for this exam is \$71. \*

Option 2—Contact your primary doctor for the exam to see if they can charge you for an annual exam at no cost using your insurance. \*

\*Request the physical form from Vantage to have the physician fill it out.

# **Background Check Form - SF-102**

We recommend going to the <u>Van Wert County Sheriff's</u> <u>Office</u> to have the FBI and Ohio Bureau of Investigation (BCI) checks completed <u>free of charge</u>. You are responsible for any costs incurred if you choose to go elsewhere. \*

Physical assessments will be conducted before admission. All Basic Peace Officer Training participants must complete an evaluation and perform to the 15<sup>th</sup> percentile of fitness based on their gender and age as defined by the New Cooper Age and Gender Based Standards for Law Enforcement.
