Re: Second System Dust Control Proposal Rev. #1

Per your request during our August 28, 2024 meeting, please find below our proposal (Rev#1) for a second dust control system for your Woodworking Shop.

The proposed second system will have the same (10,000 cfm) nominal capacity as the existing system. This will bring the dust control capability of Woodworking Shop to 20,000 cfm.

This revision (Rev#1) includes price updates from third party suppliers; also includes all new vertical drop ducts to round/round connections to production machines (existing vertical drops will not be reused) and a new service platform for the dust collector. This revision also removes (per your request and phone conversation of 11/21/2024) the BS&B explosion isolation components.

The Scope of the Design

In reference to HSI field survey performed on 12/29/2022 (Dwg 5110-P01-R2) prior to HOMAG sander installation, the dust control pickup number & sizes, and air volumes (cfm) based on 4,000 fpm air velocities are listed below:

(15) 4" dia. 350 cfm each.....	5,250 cfm
(5) 6" dia. 785 cfm each.....	3,925 cfm
(1) 8" dia. 1,400 cfm each.....	1,400 cfm

TOTAL..... 10,575 cfm

Air volume requirement for new HOMAG (2805 + 555)..... 3,360 cfm

TOTAL 13,935 cfm

Air volume requirement for new Edge-bender 1,050 cfm

TOTAL Requirement..... 14,985 cfm

The proposed second system will cover the deficit and provide an additional 5,000 cfm future growth approx. 2,500 cfm each system depending on the layout.

Item #4: Ductwork And Components

- (1) Lot of ductwork to connect existing dust pickups at the machines with all new drops to the main manifold and to filter inlet. Filter to system fan inlet. Fan outlet to a return air louver on the building wall, per attached drawing. All fabricated and designed per “SMACNA” Class II construction requirements.
 All ductwork, fittings and transitions are fabricated out of galvanized material to comply or exceed class II construction requirement with the following schedule:

Up to 8” dia.	pipes 20 ga.	fittings 20 ga.
9” to 18” dia.	pipes 20 ga.	fittings 18 ga.
19” to 30” dia.	pipes 18 ga.	fittings 16 ga.
31” & larger dia.	pipes 16 ga.	fittings 14 ga.

All ductwork up to system fan is sized at average 3,800 FPM to 4,200 FPM duct velocities.

All round ducts will have one longitudinal seam (no spiral ducts will be used). All elbows will have a minimum C.L.R.= 1.5 D with a minimum of 5 gore 90⁰ and 3 gore 45⁰ maximum. All lateral fittings will be tapered body with branches at 45⁰ maximum. All fittings and round pipes will have Van Stone flanges (floating ring flanges) at all ends. Silicone caulking will be applied between the flanges during installation. External duct work will be fabricated out of mild steel and painted to match the dust collector. At this time air return duct work does not include an outside bypass damper.

- (1) 48” x 60” Air return planum with extruded aluminum lovers.
 Wall opening/closing and wall box for return louver by customer.

Item #5: Installation

Necessary mechanical labor to install the items listed above. Also includes installation of FlameX components (mechanical only). Removal of existing duct work for new installation is also included (Customer is responsible to provide trash dumpster for the removed items and the debris). The customer is responsible for providing the necessary cranes, lifts and hoists during installation to set the equipment and to hang pipes.

Item #6: Concrete Foundation

This proposal does not include any concrete work, safety bollards, wall openings or closings. HSI will provide the suggested foundation drawings for the outside equipment.



Item #7: Electricals

This proposal includes:

- (1) 30 HP electric motor on new system Fan

No other electricals or controls or field wiring is included.

Third party equipment; Donaldson Filter, and Flamex System comes with OEM standard electricals as described in items above. Customer is responsible for all electrical installation and field wiring of these equipment. OEM standard wiring diagrams will be provided.

Item #9: Compressed Air Hookups and Plumbing

The customer is responsible for compressed air hookups to the new dust collector and water supply to FlameX system as specified on OEM terms.

Notes:

1. Labor portion of this proposal is based on non-union straight time labor rates, free access to job site during standard day time work hours. Our installation crew may work up to 12 Hrs. /Day at their choosing. Additional work, beyond the scope of the project, may be done at T&M bases. This proposal includes only one time installation crew move in/out. Additional crew move in/out time and expenses will be charged to Customer.
2. Above prices do not include freight; sales tax; permits and fees; electricals and controls; concrete foundation work; compressed air piping; plumbing; static electricity control/grounding; special roof protection; removal and/or demolition of any existing ductwork and equipment; re-routing any obstructions like conduits; tubing; etc. in the route of new installation. All wall or roof penetration including opening/closing/flashing by others.
3. The additional load carrying capacity of existing structures, ceiling trusses etc. due to new installation; and the performance of the existing equipment with the new addition is the Customer's responsibility.
4. Above prices do not include scissiors lift, forklift, crane work and such necessary for unloading and installation of the project.
