Truck Drivers are in HIGH DEMAND. This 200-hour program will provide you with the knowledge and skills necessary to take the licensing exam for a Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL) in the state of Ohio. The training program consists of 50 hours of theoretical training at Vantage Career Center and 150 hours of hands-on training within a 100-mile radius of Van Wert, Ohio. Daytime classes are completed in 5 weeks and evening classes are completed in 10 weeks.

- Pay a \$200 deposit to hold your seat!

Credential Information

Successful completers will receive a certification of completion. The instructor will assist the student with scheduling their CDL Skills Test for a Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and provide the truck needed for the skills test. A CDL License is required to drive a tractor-trailer combination or a truck with a capacity of at least 26,001 pounds Gross Vehicle Weight.
