For rural Van Wert county we used the Low Budgets for 12 months = \$20,470. Housing/food allowance makes up 53% or \$10,849. Subtracted out 30% for food leaving a housing allowance of \$7,594 12 months \$6,961 for 11 months

Transportation was calculated using the IRS Standard mileage along with average mileage traveled to and from school for our current students. Average \$15.28 per day/ 4 days per week = \$61.12 per week. PNP 44 weeks x \$61.12 = \$2,689.
