Thank you for expressing interest in the Emergency Medical Technician training program at Vantage Career Center. The Emergency Medical Technician program at Vantage Career Center provides all of the necessary training that upon successful completion of the program, all clinical time components, and testing components gives you the ability to sit for The National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians Basic exam. Success of the NREMT exam, allows you to apply for EMS certification with the State of Ohio, Division of EMS.

The Emergency Medical Technician program consists of 150 hours of training includes 20 clinical hours. Classes are held two evenings per week from 6:00pm-10:00pm.

Tuition-\$1,300, Books-\$250, additional out-of-pocket expenses

To apply for the training you must complete an application. As per ORC 4765-7 shall allow a student who is at least 17 years old, who is enrolled in the 12th or final grade in a secondary school program and who otherwise meets the requirements for admission into the EMT training program to be admitted and to complete the emergency medical technician training program. You must also submit the following:

*A Physical Health Form is provided which must be completed by a physician (Chiropractors are not acceptable).

* A Drug Screen Form is provided - You can have completed at Van Wert Occupational Health Clinic as a walk-in (first come first serve).

* A Background Check (BCI/FBI) – You can have completed at the Van Wert County Sheriff's Office for \$70. Office is opened Monday – Friday 8a – 4p closed for lunch 12p – 1p

*Certificates of completion for ICS 100 and NIMS 700. <https://training.fema.gov/nims/>

*Signed third party financial responsibility form.

After submitting your application, you can schedule your WorkKeys test with the Enrollment Coordinator.

The Emergency Medical Technician class is limited to 12 students and placement is based on a first come, first served basis. I strongly encourage anyone who is interested in enrolling in the Emergency Medical Technician program to begin the process of enrollment and completing the necessary requirements as soon as possible.
