Thank you for expressing interest in the Phlebotomy Program at Vantage Career Center. Phlebotomists work hand in hand with highly trained medical staff to assist patients in need. If you want to play a role in the healthcare field, this may be the ideal career path for you.

This certificate program provides students with 100 hours of classroom and 100 successful venipunctures in clinical and laboratory components. Classroom and clinical instructions are located at Vantage Career Center as well as local healthcare laboratory.

During our career training program, you will be given the opportunity to learn how to draw blood from individuals. The student will also learn the processing and distribution of the laboratory specimens. Also, during the program, you will learn safety standards, quality control procedures along with ethical, legal, and regulatory matters.

Graduates completing the 100 hours of classroom and 100 successful venipunctures will receive a certificate of completion and are eligible to take the NHA certification exam. Certification tests are held at Vantage Career Center.

- 18 years of age or older; may be accepted at 17 years age if otherwise meets the requirements
- Have a valid High School diploma, GED, or its recognized equivalent
- Pass a WorkKeys assessment scoring a minimum of 3 in Math, 4 in Workplace Documents (skills to read and comprehend workplace documents), 4 in Graphic Literacy (skills to locate and find information)
- Meet necessary health requirements for clinical
- BLS CPR certification

100 clock hours (70 classroom hours and 30 clinical/lab hours) Classes to meet 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm Monday and Wednesday 100 Venipunctures vary based on clinical sites Training completed in approximately 4 months
