

POLICE ACADEMY

This program provides students with the training required by the Ohio Peace Officers Training Commission (OPOTC) to pursue a career in law enforcement. It has been serving Van Wert and surrounding communities since 1994. Training is under the direction of a State of Ohio-approved Academy Commander. Upon completion of the course, students are eligible to earn the Ohio Peace Officer Certificate, which opens doors to various law enforcement opportunities.

Admission

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Hold a valid driver's license
- Possess a valid high school diploma, GED, or its equivalent
- WorkKeys Pre Entrance Exam
- Pass a drug screen, physical, and FBI & BCI background check
- Provide a copy of a 3 year BMV driving abstract
- Pass a preliminary physical conditioning assessment performing up to the 15th percentile as defined by the New Cooper Standards for Law Enforcement Fitness

Credentialing Information

To successfully complete the program, students must complete 100% of the training hours (741 hours) and pass the Physical Fitness Standards Test given near the end of the program. Successful completers will receive a certificate of completion and can take the written examination for Ohio Peace Officers. Passing the state exam entitles graduates to certification by the State of Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission (OPOTC), which is required for employment as a peace officer in the state of Ohio.
