# Vantage Adult Career Tech Scholarship (ACTS) Program



# Overview

The Vantage ACTS Program is a scholarship opportunity for adults enrolled in applicable Adult Education Programs at Vantage Career Center. Interested individuals should talk to the Vantage Financial Aid Coordinator to dicsuss eligibility.

# Criteria

- 1. Applicants must be a resident of Van Wert County, Ohio. Proof of residency is required such as:
  - · State-Issued Identification Card
  - · Utility Bill
- 2. Applicants must be enrolled in one of the following qualified Adult Career Programs at Vantage Career Center:
  - · CDL
  - EMT
  - Police
  - · LPN/RN
  - STNA
  - Phlebotomy
  - Welding
- 3. This is a need-based scholarship with financial eligibility determined by the Vantage Financial Aid Office.

### **Process**

- 1. Talk to the Vantage Financial Aid Coordinator to discuss options and eligibility.
- 2. Eligible applicants must apply online at vantagecareercenter.com.
- 3. Click on "Adult Education" and then click on "Financial Aid" on the left hand side.
- 4. Click on "Scholarship" and review the Van Wert County Foundation ACTS Scholarship.
- 5. Access the login page, create a new account, and use the code given by the Financial Aid Coordinator to access.

# **Award**

- 1. Decisions will be made as applications are submitted.
- 2. Applicants will be notified of an award decision via email.
