

Vantage Adult Career Tech Scholarship (ACTS) Program



Overview

The Vantage ACTS Program is a scholarship opportunity for adults enrolled in applicable Adult Education Programs at Vantage Career Center. Interested individuals should talk to the Vantage Financial Aid Coordinator to discuss eligibility.

Criteria

1. Applicants must be a resident of Van Wert County, Ohio. Proof of residency is required such as:
 - State-Issued Identification Card
 - Utility Bill
2. Applicants must be enrolled in one of the following qualified Adult Career Programs at Vantage Career Center:
 - CDL
 - EMT
 - Police
 - LPN/RN
 - STNA
 - Phlebotomy
 - Welding
3. This is a need-based scholarship with financial eligibility determined by the Vantage Financial Aid Office.

Process

1. Talk to the Vantage Financial Aid Coordinator to discuss options and eligibility.
2. Eligible applicants must apply online at vantagecareercenter.com.
3. Click on "Adult Education" and then click on "Financial Aid" on the left hand side.
4. Click on "Scholarship" and review the Van Wert County Foundation ACTS Scholarship.
5. Access the login page, create a new account, and use the code given by the Financial Aid Coordinator to access.

Award

1. Decisions will be made as applications are submitted.
2. Applicants will be notified of an award decision via email.
